Experience Seoul, South Korea in summer 2023! Explore the causes and consequences of variations in family patterns among diverse and dynamic societies and gain an understanding of various aspects of global family issues. Examine how major geo-political issues influence the lived experiences of families in South Korea differently than in the United States. Through guest lectures, group discussion, and experiential learning activities, students will apply course concepts and theories to real world situations while immersed in the Korean culture. Highlights include a community service project working with local multicultural families, visits to Gyeongbokgung Palace and Bukchon Village, and an excursion to the Korean Demilitarized Zone.
